

LSOA population profile: E01032232, Redditch 003A, Batchley

Population

- Batchley has a population 1,527 person, 775 (50.8%) of which are males
- Batchley has a younger age structure than Worcestershire and England
- Batchley has a lower proportion of people aged 65 and over, and a high proportion of working age adults.
- Batchley has a notably high proportion of people aged 50-59 who will reach pension age in the next fifteen years
- Batchley has a relatively high proportion of residents from a minority ethnic background compared to Worcestershire.
- Almost 7% of residents in Batchley are Asian or Asian British – compares to just over 3% in Worcestershire.
- Over 3% of residents in Batchley are from a Mixed ethnic background – compares to less than 2% in Worcestershire.



Health Profile

- Batchley has lower self-reported good health than Worcestershire and England.
- 2.4% of people in Batchley are in Very Bad health, over double the value in Worcestershire and England.
- 5.8% of people in Batchley are in Bad health, higher than Worcestershire (3.9%) and England (4.0%)



Disability

- Batchley has a higher proportion of residents disabled than is the case in Worcestershire and England
- Almost 25% of residents in Batchley are disabled under the Equality Act. This compares to 18% in the county, and just over 17% nationally.
- Almost 12% of residents in Batchley have their day-to-day activities limited a lot due to a disability. This is higher than Worcestershire (7.2%) and England (7.3%). This is despite Batchley having a younger age structure than Worcestershire and England



LSOA deprivation for Batchley

- Batchley is in IMD decile 2, so is in the top 20% most deprived areas in the country.
- Batchley is in IMD decile 1 for the Employment, Education, Skills & Training, and Health Deprivation & Disability domains
- Batchley is in IMD decile 2 for Income, and in IMD decile 3 for Crime and Barriers to Housing & Services



Housing

- Batchley has a notably high proportion of people living in one-person households than Worcestershire and England.
- Almost 46% of residents in Batchley live in one-person households – compares to less than 30% in Worcestershire and just over 30% in England
